The following transportation services list has been compiled for the senior residents in the City of Irvine. Costs and types of services will vary. Service: Available to Irvine residents (age 18+) with permanent disabilities and senior citizens over 65 **WHO CAN NO LONGER DRIVE.**

- Door-to-door service.
- Lift equipped vehicles; wheelchairs accepted.
- Service area is limited to the City of Irvine and adjacent cities.
- Shuttle services to Lakeview Senior Center.
- Shopping Shuttles to various markets in Irvine.
- Fees reflect transportation provided each way.
- Rides are on a first come-first served basis and must be scheduled in advance.

Cost:

- Annual registration fee (\$25 initial, \$20 annual)
- \$1.90 each location in Irvine.
- \$3.80 for non-emergency medical appointments; \$5.70 for all other essential needs to Costa Mesa, Newport Beach, North Laguna Hills, East Santa Ana, Tustin, Lake Forest, and North Aliso Viejo.
- Call for ride fees to the approved medical facilities beyond the service areas indicated above.
- Lakeview Senior Center Quarterly pass also available

Give them your home address FIRST to ensure you live within their service area.

Service: Door-to-door van service for those unable to use the fixed route service because of a disability.
Wheelchair access. Passengers must go through certification for eligibility.

Cost: Curb-to-curb service at pickup and destination = \$2.25 each way
Door-to-door service at either pickup or destination = \$6.25 each way
Door-to-curb, Curb to Door service at both pickup and destination = \$10.25 each way

PARTICIPANT CRITERIA:

- Must be at least 60 years of age; ineligible for OCTA ACCESS services; or eligible but cannot reasonably use ACCESS for the specific required trip.
- Must reside within Orange County's designated service area, which includes the cities of Irvine, Mission Viejo, Laguna Woods, Laguna Niguel, Laguna Hills, Laguna Beach, Newport Beach, San Clemente, San Juan Capistrano, Aliso Viejo, Lake Forest, Dana Point and Rancho Santa Margarita.
- Required to have a Denial Letter from OCTA to receive services from So. Co. Senior Transportation).

SERVICE:

- Senior non-emergency medical appointment transportation
- All transportation services must originate within Orange County designated service area
- Rides outside the service area are subject to a fifteen-mile limit from the resident's address to their destination.
- Rides must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance
- Riders will be charged \$ 2.00 per ride and must have exact change

- Monday thru Friday @ 8:00 – 4:30 p.m.
- Transportation not available on major holidays

- Requests are limited to two times a month
- Requests require 48-hour advance notice
- Unable to accommodate wheelchairs
- Cities outside Irvine limited
