

Attention Early Childhood Students!

You can get reimbursed for college fees.

Irvine Valley College has a grant from the Child Development Training Consortium to reimburse students for college fees.

Funded by the Child Development Division of the California Department of Education, the Consortium was created to address the critical shortage of qualified child care workers in California. It reimburses fees for students who work directly with children in a licensed or license-exempt (e.g., military) child care program. This includes both **public and private** infant, toddler and preschool centers; family child care programs; before/ after school child care programs; and kindergarten classroom aide positions. (Other elementary education aides do not qualify.)

Students must be taking classes (all except physical education count) and working toward a Child Development Permit. ECE students working toward their Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree also qualify.

Your Early Childhood Instructor will hand out a Participant Profile/application at the beginning of each semester.
