The Community Services Department is now accepting applications for its Adult Softball Program Spring 2015 season. Men’s and Coed leagues are now being formed. The season tentatively runs from February 2, 2015 through April 12, 2015. All leagues will play a ten game season.

Irvine softball leagues are governed by Southern California Municipal Athletic Federation (SCMAF) rules, except as modified by Irvine by-laws. Use of multi-walled/skinned/shelled or multi-layered bats, titanium bats, or bats with composite barrels are not permitted. For a complete copy of the by-laws please call (949) 724-6669.

1. PROCEDURE TO ENTER A TEAM

A. The **deadline** for submitting the league fees, team roster, and questionnaire is

B. Please make check payable to "City of Irvine". **NOTE: Only one personal check per team.** (Have players make checks out to one person and have that person write the check for the team fees). **Please write team name and check writer's driver's license number on front of the personal check.** Payment can also be made with cash or debit/credit card (paid in person or over the phone)

C. Rosters must be submitted on an official City of Irvine Spring 2015 softball roster or an exact replica.

D. All entries received after the deadline will be placed if spots are available.

E. Teams that do not qualify for placement in the league will be notified and issued a full refund.

F. Any team that wishes to withdraw after having submitted their roster and fee will be subject to the following penalty schedule:

2. ELIGIBILITY

- A. Players must be at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before the first league game. All players must have a picture ID available at all games.
- B. A maximum of two women may be rostered on a "Men's" team.
- C. Players may not play on more than one team in the same league.

4. ROSTERS

- A. Each team shall submit an official, completed roster of no more than sixteen (16) players. Players must sign the roster **AT THE PARK OFFICE WITH A PICTURE ID** before playing. This will be done at the first game that each player plays during a given season.
- B. UP TO 10 ROSTER ADDITIONS (no deletions are permitted) may be made up until the start of your seventh league game. **No** roster changes may be made between January 15th and your first game. All roster changes must be made at the park office where the team is scheduled to play and placed directly onto the roster filed at the park office.

****Closed Field League – Games are played on a field with a 200' fence. If a male batter hits it over the fence it's an automatic out. If a female batter hits it over the fence it's a homerun. (this league is recommended for new/beginning teams)**
