



The City of Irvine Invites Your Comments on Environmental Issues

A Notice of Preparation (NOP) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the City of Irvine CEQA Guidelines has been released for a 30-day comment period that began on February 3, 2014. The purpose of the NOP is to solicit input from individuals, organizations and public agencies on environmental issues that should be addressed in the Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (EIR) being prepared for the PA 17/33 General Plan Amendment and Zone Change Project. Space is provided below for your input to be included in this public comment process.

The NOP included an Initial Study that identified the following potentially significant environmental issues to be addressed in the Supplemental EIR:

- Aesthetics / Visual Resources
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- Hazards and Hazardous Materials
- Noise
- Transportation and Circulation
- Mandatory Findings of Significance
- Air Quality
- Geology and Soils
- Land Use and Planning
- Hydrology and Water Quality
- Utilities, Service Systems and Energy
