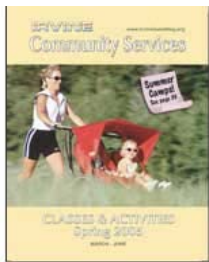

Nature's Nectar

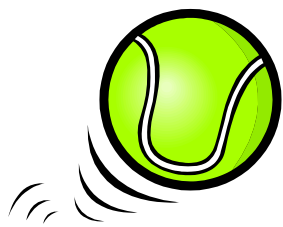
Saturday, April 2, 9-11am at Bommer Canyon - FREE
